The Dedham-Westwood Water District is required by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP) to develop a Water Service Line Inventory with a focus on identifying lead services by October 2024.

The District's water system comprises over 13,000 service line connections and 210 miles of water main. By conducting this inventory, the District will be able to proactively plan how to address lead in our system and create a removal plan.
